

DVD Flick – video compilation & DVD burning for Windows 2000/XP/Vista/7

Short form manual for burning a DVD, with files created on a Video Engineering Pipe Pal 1/2/3:

- 1) Remove the flash drive from your Pipe Pal & fit this to a USB socket on your PC.
- 2) Navigate to the folder of your recordings on your flash drive (winbutton + E, -> "My Recordings").
- 3) Open the DVD Flick program.

For a single survey consisting of a single recorded file(a):

4a) Drag and drop the recorded file into the DVD Flick main window (if program pauses run the cursor over the dialogue box).

5a) Double click the file in DVD Flick to open a properties dialog box.

In GENERAL, change the name to the name of the survey (eg "246 Queen Street")

In CHAPTERS de-select "Create chapters on every video source".

Click ACCEPT.

Go to step **6)**

For a single survey consisting of several recorded files(b):

4b) Drag and drop the first recorded file into the DVD Flick main window (if program pauses run the cursor over the dialogue box).

5b) Double click the file in DVD Flick to open a properties dialog box.

In GENERAL, change the name to the name of the survey (eg "246 Queen Street")

In CHAPTERS de-select "Create chapters on every video source".

In VIDEO SOURCES, either 1) Click ADD, select the recordings folder on your flash drive, then highlight all the other recorded files in the survey (hold down CTRL key & click each with left mouse button), then click OPEN. 2) Alternately you can just highlight the files & drag these into the VIDEO SOURCES window (if program pauses run the cursor over the dialogue box). You can change the replay order with the move buttons.

Click ACCEPT.

Go to step **6)**

For several surveys consisting of several recorded files each(c):

4c) Drag and drop the first recorded file of the first/next survey into the DVD Flick main window (if program pauses run the cursor over the dialogue box).

5c) Double click the file in DVD Flick to open a properties dialog box.

In GENERAL, change the name to the name of the survey (eg "246 Queen Street")

In CHAPTERS de-select "Create chapters on every video source".

In VIDEO SOURCES, either 1) Click ADD, select the recordings folder on your flash drive, then highlight all the other recorded files in the survey (hold down CTRL key & click each with left mouse button), then click OPEN. 2) Alternately you can just highlight the files & drag these into the VIDEO SOURCES window (if program pauses run the cursor over the dialogue box). You can change the replay order with the move buttons.

Repeat steps 4c) & 5c) for each further survey.

Go to step **6)**

6) Select PROJECT SETTINGS (on the top menu bar)

In GENERAL, change the title from "unnamed project" to, for example your "company name", as this will appear on the opening menu.

Change the "Encoder" priority from "below normal" to "above normal" for the fastest encode.

In VIDEO, set "Target format" to "PAL".

In BURNING, select "Burn project to disc" and select the speed to match your media.

Click ACCEPT.

7) Select MENU SETTINGS (on the top menu bar)

Select the menu type that you prefer (suggest MOSAIC)

Click ACCEPT.

8) Select CREATE DVD (on the top menu bar)

Respond to any prompts (eg: Yes & OK)
